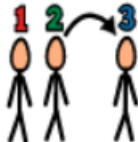
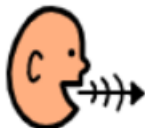

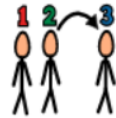

 We have created a model of how the flat might look












 You can see it in the theatre in Upper Springland








 It is accessible and staff, customers and families can visit





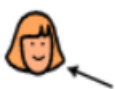
Our new Co-Production Leader is Jennifer Dalrymple

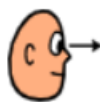

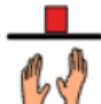

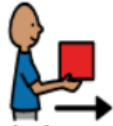
