- Our recruitment processes adhere to safer recruitment principles, ensuring that those who work with us share our commitment to safeguarding.
- We work closely with regulatory bodies, local authorities, and safeguarding partners to ensure best practices and compliance with Child and Adult Protection policies.
- Our safeguarding approach is continuously reviewed and improved through internal audits, inspections, and quality assurance measures.
